1. White: Pure, clean, and versatile

RGB: (255, 255, 255)
Usage: Walls, ceilings, base furniture

2. Off-White: Soft and warm

Usage: Trim, textiles, accents



3. Light Gray: Subtle and sophisticated

Usage: Furniture, flooring, soft furnishings

4. Mid Gray: Modern and balanced

Usage: Walls, furniture, accents



5. Charcoal: Strong and grounding

2. Color Application in Minimalist Design
